

# Park City High School PSTO Meeting

January 12, 2010

Present: Shauna Engen, Dale Cohen, Julie Eihausen, Lisa Dilley, Joanne Vincent, Rose Pershe, Debbi Bessembinder, Joanie Engram-Bibb.

The meeting was called to order at 9:38.

1. Welcome and Introductions.
2. Minutes: The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Julie made a motion to approve the minutes. Joanie seconded. Motion passed.
3. Treasurer's Report: Julie Eihausen. (See attached)
  - A. Grad night has about \$6000.
  - B. There is approximately \$3300 in the budget that is unallocated and available to spend, but we need to leave some to rollover for next year.
  - C. Income:
    1. Water bottles are selling.
    2. More money was made than expected on Lagoon.
    3. There will most likely be no more money from Albertson's Community Partners.
  - D. Honor Roll may need more money.
  - E. Club Support: \$1000 was returned to that line item at the last meeting. Student Council has purchased noise makers (Bam-Bams) to be used at all winter sporting events at a cost of \$1900 and they are looking for funding to cover the cost of this purchase. It was decided to wait for a proposal from them to see if we need to add back more money or if they have someplace else to help fund this.
  - F. A decision needs to be made as to whether the PTSO will be sponsoring Community Scholarships at the same level as last year. Last year several more scholarships were added due to the larger budget. It was decided to wait until the next meeting to make a decision on this issue.
4. Grad-Night: Joanie Engram-Bibb met with J.J. Ehlers and Tani Doering. They will be splitting up overseeing responsibilities for Grad Night. They would like to have an eblast requesting volunteers from Junior and Senior parents. A list of jobs will be prepared so that volunteers will know exactly what their commitment will be and maybe more people will volunteer if they know their level of commitment at the outset. A survey is being sent to seniors to see what they want to have at Grad Night. A possible new location being explored is Jupiter Bowl. Also suggested was to look to the elementary and middle school and the district PTSOs for financial support to help fund Grad Night. A letter needs to be drafted, to be sent by Connie and Hilary, to explain why the other PTSOs should help support this event. Julie and Shauna will bring this up for discussion at Friday's District PTSO meeting so that the other schools will know that this is coming.
5. Booster Club: The Region swim meet is coming up and will be hosted at the Ecker Hill Pool. There will be a Booster Club meeting Thursday. They are looking for a Co-president.
6. Sweetheart Dance: There is only one priority table left for the Sweetheart Dance (Band Fundraiser)
