



## Park City High School 2018 Community Scholarship Application

### Step 1: Obtain a Scholarship Application

- Applications are available April 1st- April 30<sup>th</sup>, 20178

### Step 2: Select and apply for up to 3 Scholarships

- Review the Community Scholarship Program list of scholarships
- Not all applicants will receive a scholarship.
- Applicants will not be able to receive more than one scholarship.

### Step 3: Complete Your Paper Application by 3pm on April 30<sup>th</sup> (Due to Ms.Silvestri, in the Counseling Office)

- Please check the requirements for each scholarship you are applying for.
- FYI - We will include a transcript of your grades through 3rd quarter with your application.

- A. Personal information (*This is the only page that should have your name on it*)
- B. Scholarship Selection
- C. Educational Information; we will put your portfolio number here
- D. College Application Information
- E. Scholarship Essay - Must be typed on separate paper
- F. Short Answer Questions - Must be typed on separate paper
- G. Additional Materials (If required by specific scholarship)

**IMPORTANT:** Submit an application for each scholarship you apply for. Example: If you apply for 3 scholarships, include 3 copies. If one of them includes additional material, only include it with that application. Please label each application with the name of scholarship. Do not hole punch or add plastic covers.

**Review Process:**

The review process is blind, meaning that the reviewers will not see your name in the process. The scholarship donors or volunteers will review applicants based on your scholarship selection.

An Awards Ceremony will be held at 8:00 a.m., on Wednesday, May 30th in the Eccles Center to celebrate the scholarship recipients. Please tentatively plan on attending with your parents and/or family. **You will be notified if you have received a scholarship prior to the ceremony.**

**VERY IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ:**

**Receiving your Scholarship:**

**You must show proof of college enrollment by October 1, 2018.**

Checks will be sent to your institution for tuition and fees. If you pay your tuition bill and show proof of payment, your check may be written to you for reimbursement on a case-by-case basis.

You must also write a handwritten thank you note to your donor and deliver it to Ms. Silvestri by Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, so she can deliver it to the donor on your behalf.

If you defer your admissions, you will have two years to collect your scholarship (October 1, 2020). You must show proof an approved college deferment (religious mission, military service or other approved deferment requests).

If you do not defer your admissions and do not collect your scholarship by October 1st, 2018, your scholarship will go back to the donor or to the general scholarship fund.
