Parent Release Disclosure: Available at the discretion of the student's parent or legal guardian, Parent Release gives students the opportunity to be released for part of the school day for necessary regularly occurring off-campus activities. **During release time, the student may NOT be on any school campus.** Students must leave campus within five minutes of their last class.
