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Dear Parents or Guardians:

Please pick up any medication or medical supplies your student may have in the health room before the last day of school. We cannot store medication over the summer. Any medication left in the school will be discarded.

All students requiring medication to be given at school must have a **new** Park City School District medication form completed **each year** by parent and physician.

Students in grades 8-12 may carry 1 days supply of non-prescription medication in original container. Asthma inhalers, diabetic supplies, Epi-pens, and pancreatic enzymes may also be carried by students *when medication forms are filed with school.*

All students with asthma whose parent request they carry an inhaler must have an Asthma Self Administration form completed **each school year**. The prescribing physician and parent must sign this form. This form must be brought to the school before a student may carry his/her inhaler. The asthma inhaler must have the student's name on it.

Students requiring Epi-pens must complete the Epi-pen Auto Injector Authorization form **each school year**. The prescribing physician and parent must sign this form. All forms must be brought to the school secretary before a student may carry his/her own Epi pen.

Medication forms are available on the school district web site www.pcschools.us under Departments, Health Services, then select Care Plans and Forms.

Contact the school nurse the first week of school if your student has a health concern or requires medications at school.
