



The Park City School District does not offer Driver Education. Students need to complete both the classroom theory and driving and observation portions through a provider who is approved by the Utah Driver License Division. Some popular provider options are listed below. *These programs are not necessarily endorsed by the Park City School District. Contact the provider directly for more information.*

NOTE: You must get a Learner Permit BEFORE you begin Driver Education.

Utah Students Connect (USC) offers the classroom theory portion of Driver Education online, but NOT the driving portion. The student must be enrolled at TMJH or PCHS. This course is free during the school year, but will cost \$45 if taken during the summer. USC courses have fixed term dates!—A sign-up deadline, start date, withdrawal deadline, and an end date when all course work and final exams must be complete. You must actively participate or you will be automatically dropped at mid-term. Students will receive a letter grade for this course, which will be added to the student's high school transcript (and will affect GPA). If completed successfully, the student will be awarded .25 elective credit. You must have a Learner Permit before you can begin the course. **Register for USC Driver Education through your school's Counseling Office.**

NUES On-line Driver's Education Program (<http://nucenter.org/DriversEd.html>)

The Northern Utah Education Service Center (NUES) is offering an On-line Driver's Education Program for students enrolled in the Park City School District. The course costs \$40 (non-refundable), and must be completed within 90 days of receiving a login to the Canvas system. This course provides the classroom portion, but NOT the driving portion.
