

- PS 1 Students will recognize some memorized words and phrases when they hear them spoken. ([NL.IL](#))
- PS 2 Students will recognize some letters or characters and understand some learned memorized words and phrases when I read. ([NL.IR](#))
- PS 3 Students will communicate on very familiar topics using single words and phrases that they have practiced and memorized. ([NM.IC](#))
- PS 4 Students will present information about themselves and some other very familiar topics using a variety of words, phrases, or memorized expressions. ([NM.PS](#))
- PS 5 Students will write lists and memorized phrases on familiar topics. ([NW.PW](#))
- PS 6 Students will often understand words, phrases, and simple sentences related to everyday life. Students will recognize pieces of information and sometimes understand the main topic of what is being said. ([NH.IL](#))
- PS 7 Students will understand familiar words, phrases, and sentences within short and simple texts related to everyday life. Students will sometimes understand the main idea of what they have read. ([NH.IR](#))
- PS 8 Students will communicate and exchange information about familiar topics using phrases and simple sentences, sometimes supported by memorized language. They can usually handle short social interactions in everyday situations by asking and answering simple questions. ([NH.IC](#))
- PS 9 Students will present basic information on familiar topics using language they have practiced using phrases and simple sentences. ([NH.PS](#))
- PS 10 Students will write short messages and notes on familiar topics related to everyday life. ([NH.PW](#))
- PS 11 Students can identify some products and practices of cultures. ([N.CPP](#))
- PS 12 Students will I can identify some basic cultural beliefs and values. ([N.CP](#))
