

- PS 1 Students will understand the main idea in short, simple messages and presentations on familiar topics. Students will understand the main idea of simple conversations that they overhear. ([IL.IL](#))
- PS 2 Students will understand the main idea of short and simple texts when the topic is familiar. ([IL.IR](#))
- PS 3 Students will communicate and exchange information about familiar topics using phrases and simple sentences, sometimes supported by memorized language. Students can usually handle short social interactions in everyday situations by asking and answering simple questions. ([IL.IC](#))
- PS 4 Students will participate in conversations on a number of familiar topics using simple sentences. They can handle short social interactions in everyday situations by asking and answering simple questions. ([IL.PS](#))
- PS 5 Students will present information on most familiar topics using a series of simple sentences. ([IL.PS](#))
- PS 6 Students will write briefly about most familiar topics and provide information using a series of simple sentences. ([IL.PW](#))
- PS 7 Students will understand the main idea in messages and presentations on a variety of topics related to everyday life and personal interests and studies. Students can understand the main idea in conversations that they overhear. ([IM.IL](#))
- PS 8 Students will understand the main idea of texts related to everyday life and personal interests or studies. ([IM.IR](#))
- PS 9 Students will participate in conversations on familiar topics using sentences and series of sentences. They can handle short social interactions in everyday situations by asking and answering a variety of questions. Students can usually say what they want to say about themselves and their everyday lives. ([IM.IC](#))
- PS 10 Students will make presentations on a wide variety of familiar topics using connected sentences. ([IM.PS](#))
- PS 11 Students will write on a wide variety of familiar topics using connected sentences. ([IM.PW](#))
