Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back to Park City High School! I look forward to a great year with our Miner Nation. This letter is to provide you with information regarding what Back to School will look like at PCHS with the ultimate goal of providing a safe learning environment for all.

I want you to be aware of some important updates:

- PCHS will have a modified schedule on our first two days of school August 20-21. 10th graders (and any 9th graders that come from Treasure Mountain) will attend on Thursday, August 20. 11th and 12th graders will attend on Friday, August 21. Please see the attached bell schedule for those modified days.
- Back to School Night will be held virtually on August 24th.
- While we normally welcome our parents on campus, this year Park City High School must limit building access to essential personnel and students only. All parent/guardian appointments will be conducted virtually. If you need immediate assistance, our front office staff will help direct you as needed.

Our enrollment numbers remain steady as we finalize registration for both in-person and remote learning. This Friday, PowerSchool will be available to students to view their course schedules. More information will be coming from our counseling department.

For those that have chosen remote learning to start the school year, you should have received an email with detailed information and an acknowledgement agreement. This agreement must be received prior to being designated as a remote learner. An important focus this summer has been on mitigating the COVID-19 risks as we prepare to have our students and staff back on campus. As a parent or guardian, you may have a lot of questions about what the school day will look like, such as classroom set-up, lunch, and hallway transitions.
