## **Welcome to Remote Learning!**

To help ensure the success of students who participate in remote learning, we have designed a structured program for you. This document describes the remote learning program in Park City School District for the first quarter or trimester of learning. Students and families should review this document together so there is a shared understanding of the expectations for remote learning. Specific information for students' class(es) will be provided to you by your school prior to the beginning of remote learning *on Monday, August 24, 2020*. We will be verifying all students' technology is working and that we are ready to go with remote learning on August 20 and August 21 via email.

### **Content Delivery & Device:**

All remote learning students will use their district-issued electronic device to participate in remote learning. Students will log-in to the appropriate learning management system (LMS) to access learning activities. The chart below describes the device and LMS by grade level.

Grades:K-2  
LMS: Seesaw  
Student Device:iPad

Grades: 3-12  
LMS: Canvas  
Student Device: Laptop

### **Technical Issues:**

If you need support or assistance with your electronic device, please contact your school.

### **Daily Schedule:**

Each student will follow the daily schedule from their school and/or remote learning teacher. While there are differences in the schedule at each grade level, all students are expected to follow the learning schedule and be available for synchronous learning activities as outlined in the schedule.

### **Attendance and Grading:**

Similar to in-person learning, teachers will take attendance regularly and grades will be assigned. Students are expected to follow the daily learning schedule provided and communicate with the teacher when this is not possible. Each teacher will provide specific expectations regarding attendance and grading as part of their class disclosure.

### **Online Safety and Digital Citizenship:**

Please be aware there are several PCSD policies (BP 5010, 10001, 7031) that describe and inform the use of electronic devices, bullying and cyberbullying, and social media.

**PCHS Remote Learning:**

Park City High School remote learning students will remain in their current courses and schedule, while working from home through Canvas. Remote learning in some electives may not be recommended.

Remote learning requires a partnership between parents, students, and Park City High School. Students will need to meet their teacher's expectations for class requirements remotely, including following established deadlines, checking canvas and email daily, and participating in synchronous and asynchronous activities as assigned.

Remote learners at PCHS need to identify which courses they will be participating in remotely. Some students may have a combination of remote and on campus courses. To be designated as a remote learner in one or more courses at PCHS, parents and students must complete the [Remote Learning Agreement](#) quarterly.

While the option remains to complete courses fully online through Utah Students Connect, Utah's SOEP program, and private providers, PCHS is now able to offer the robust course catalog remotely.

PCHS is excited to offer this opportunity and appreciate your patience as we work through the details of our remote learning offerings at Park City High School.
