

Utah Valley University Concurrent Enrollment Checklist – Park City High School

HOW TO ENROLL IN UVU CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT:

See the UVU website www.uvu.edu/concurrent for official information and deadlines!

STEP 1. Admissions – Become a UVU Student

The admissions application is required. If you've already been admitted to UVU, you still need to apply, but you won't be charged the fee. Note the admissions deadline!

- Go to <https://www.uvu.edu/concurrent>, Step #1 and complete the UVU admission application.
- Pay the \$35 admission fee online.
- Receive your UVID number once you're admitted. You will get your 8-digit UVID via email 24-48 hours after submission.

STEP 2. Registration – Register for your UVU Courses

Register for full-year and fall semester courses in the Fall (note those deadlines). Register for spring semester courses in the Spring (note those deadlines).

- Go to www.uvu.edu/concurrent, Step #2 "Registration".
- Go to the "Know Your Prerequisites" section and view the Prerequisite List to confirm if you meet course requirements. **If your course has prerequisites, you must:**
 - Ask PCHS to send your Transcript and ACT scores to UVU. Note the prerequisites deadline! ****Sign up on the online [ACT Scores/Transcript Request Form](#). You must have your UVID.** NOTE: If you don't have qualifying ACT scores, you may substitute qualifying ALEKS or Accuplacer placement test scores. See the back page of this guide for testing info.
- Go to the "Find Your Course" section and click the Concurrent Enrollment "Locate Your Course CRN" link to find your CRN for each course.
- Go to the "Get Registered" section and register through myUVU. You must have your UVID and CRNs in order to register. You may not be able to register for courses until prerequisites are met.
- Complete any additional required steps per the UVU registration website.

NOTE: The university may place a hold on your registration. If you are unable to proceed with registration, call UVU Concurrent Enrollment at 801-863-8376.

STEP 3. Pay UVU Tuition

- Courses cost \$5 per UVU credit hour. Go to www.uvu.edu/concurrent, Step #3 "Pay Tuition" for payment options. Note the payment deadlines.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CE COURSES:

For Academic courses, 3.0 Cumulative GPA on accredited school transcript.

For CTE courses, 2.0 Cumulative GPA on accredited school transcript.

PREREQUISITES – OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT AND/OR TEST SCORES REQUIRED:

English 1010 and English 1010/2010

- Be a Senior and pass 10th and 11th grade English with B averages or better, **AND**
- Have an ACT score of 19+ in English and 19+ in Reading, **OR**
 - Have an ACT score of 20+ in English and 18+ in Reading, **OR**
 - Have an ACT score of 18+ in English and 20+ in Reading, **OR**
 - Substitute ACT scores with qualifying Accuplacer placement test scores.
- For English 2010, completion of English 1010 with a C- or better, **OR**
 - Have ACT scores of 29+ in English and Reading, **OR**
 - Earn English 1010 credit by scoring 3 or better on the AP English Language exam.

Math 1010

- Complete Secondary Math 1, 2, and 3 courses with a C average each year, **OR**
- Complete Secondary Math 1, 2, and 3 **AND** have a qualifying test score:
 - ACT or ACT-R Math score of 19+, **OR**
 - ALEKS placement test score ≥ 30

Math 1030 and Math/Stats 1040

- Complete Secondary Math 1, 2, and 3 courses with a C average each year, **OR**
- Complete Secondary Math 1, 2, and 3 **AND** have a qualifying test score:
 - ACT or ACT-R Math score of 23+, **OR**
 - ALEKS placement test score of $\geq 46-60$

Math 1050 and Math 1060

- Complete Secondary Math 1, 2, and 3 courses with a C average each year **AND**
- For 1050, an ACT Math score of 23+ **OR** complete Math 1010 with a C or better.
- For 1060, an ACT Math score of 25+ **OR** complete Math 1050 with a C or better.
- You may substitute an ACT score with an ALEKS placement test score of $\geq 46-60$

Philosophy 2050 (PCHS Ethics)

- Be a high school Senior **AND**
- Complete English 1010 with a C- or better, **OR**
 - Have an ACT score of 29+ in English and 29+ in Reading, **OR**
 - Score 3 or higher on the AP English Language or AP English Literature Exam (official AP exam scores must be sent directly to UVU prior to the deadline).

Spanish and French 3116, 3117, and 3118

- AP Language and Culture exam score of 3 or higher (College Board must send an official score report directly to UVU, order at <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/>)

PLACEMENT TESTING:

If you don't have qualifying ACT scores for prerequisite courses, you can take the ALEKS and/or Accuplacer tests via the UVU Testing Center to try to qualify based on those test scores.

- The **ALEKS** test is used for Math placement. The test fee is \$5 per official proctored test attempt. (Online practice assessments may also be available to determine your current level of math readiness. A subscription fee is required for practice tests for CE students and can be set up through your myUVU account.)
- The **Accuplacer** test is used for English placement and consists of two sections, Reading and Writing. The test fee is \$10 for the first time and retakes are \$10 per section thereafter. Up to three retakes allowed in a two-week period.

*****To take a placement exam, you must first schedule your exam online at <https://www.uvu.edu/testingservices/>. You may have the option for either an in-person (on campus) exam or an at-home remote proctored exam. Read all the options and information provided.**
